Baxter Pool Party Rules

1. Set up and Clean up is the party host responsibility
2. The Association will not loan or lease Association furniture for your event. You are responsible for bringing your own furniture to the "approve" pool party location.
3. All trash associated with your event must be disposed of in the dumpster in the parking lot of each pool. Event trash must not be disposed of in pool deck trash cans.
4. Party host may not have use of the interior of the clubhouse unless renting the clubhouse.
5. Depending on the number of non-member guest, an additional lifeguard may be required at the expense of the party host.
6. A \$50.00 deposit payable to Baxter Community Association will be required at the time of reservation to insure that all rules are followed and returned the next business day following the event.

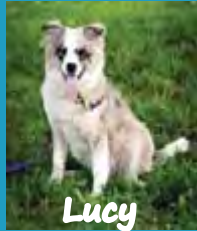

When Nature Calls

It's fun to get out and find new things to do or new places to do old things. It's even better when a new activity or place can involve the entire family. I imagine a number of you have ridden a bicycle in the past. Some probably still do, while others may not have been on a bike in years. There is a trail in the southwest corner of Virginia that is all downhill, follows an old railroad bed, and passes along rivers and through forests. It is a trail anyone can do, and makes for a wonderful ride.

In 1907 the Virginia Carolina Railroad was created and eventually stretched from Abingdon, Virginia to Elkland, North Carolina. It was named the Virginia Creeper Trail after a native plant that grows along the route, and was used to haul iron ore, lumber, and supplies. In 1977 the last train made the final run on the trail, and shortly thereafter local towns and clubs began to purchase the rights of way and convert the old rail bed to a multi-use trail. The new Virginia Creeper Trail, opened in 1984, now runs 35 miles from Whitetop Mountain on the Virginia/NC border through Damascus, Virginia and on to Abingdon, Virginia, and is open for hiking, backpacking and bike riding.

The trip from Whitetop Mountain to Damascus is the most popular section of the trail and runs downhill for 18.5 miles. There are half a dozen bike rental businesses in Damascus that will rent bikes and shuttle riders to Whitetop Mountain for the easy and beautiful ride back to Damascus. You'll start the ride at a duplicate of the Whitetop Depot, rebuilt in 2000 to replicate the original building, which houses a small information center for the trail. From there, it is all downhill.

The ride from Whitetop Mountain to Damascus passes over 23 railroad trestles, one that is 500 feet long, spanning the Whitetop Laurel River. It follows Green Cove and Whitetop Laurel Creeks, joins the Appalachian Trail for a short time, and passes through Taylor's Valley, where you'll find delis and ice cream shops. You can easily make the trip in a couple of hours. But, I'd recommend taking your time and stopping to enjoy the mountain views and flowing creeks. You can even pack a lunch to enjoy along one of the creeks. If you don't want to ride the entire 18.5 miles, there are a number of access points with ample parking along the trail. One such access point, located on Road 748, has a parking area below the 500 foot trestle and offers access to Whitetop Laurel Creek for fishing as well as to the trail.

Damascus is about a four hour drive from Fort Mill, so you may want to plan an overnight stay in Damascus in an inn, cabin, bed & breakfast, or a camp ground. A quick search on the internet will result in lodging and dining choices in the area. 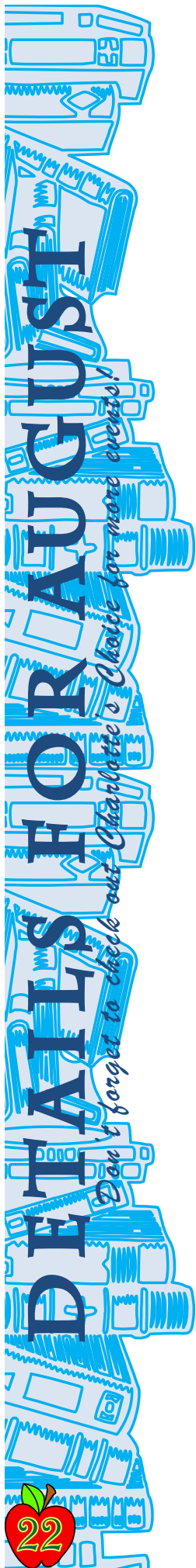
